Getting Started

1. URL address: www.unitedstreaming.com
2. Enter login name
3. Press Tab
4. Enter password
5. Press Enter (or Return if using a Mac) on your keyboard
6. The Home screen for Discovery Education *streaming*TM appears

If Windows Media and Stand-Alone Application is selected on a Macintosh, closed captioning will appear when the video segment is streamed.

Getting Started with Discovery Education *streaming*TM

Search by Keyword

1. Type exactly what you're looking for in the keyword search box and click GO. Results will match every word in your query. Use quotation marks for specific results with results matching those words only in that order. Target your keyword searches with conjunctive searches. Capitalize the following words or use the appropriate symbol: AND or + NOT or -



2. The following results will appear:

List showing number of videos, video clips, images, articles, audio files, speeches, quizzes, events, lesson plans, and clip art.



3. Many Unitedstreaming titles come with **Teacher's Guides** and **Blackline Masters**. (lessons and student activities) Adobe Acrobat Reader is required to view the guides. If needed, visit www.adobe.com to download the free "Acrobat Reader".
4. Several Unitedstreaming titles may be viewed with **Closed Captioning**. This feature is available only if using Windows Media Player. Closed Captioning is not currently available for Macs using QuickTime.
